Today we performed your **EARLY SPRING** lawn treatment.

It consists of the following:

Fertilizer, Crabgrass Control, & Broadleaf Weed Control

Do's....

- keep kids & pets off lawn for 2 -4 hours or until completely dry.
- ♦ limit the amount of activity on the lawn for the first 24 hours.
- mow regularly as needed but no lower than 2
 1/2"(2 1/2" to 3" is recommended for spring).

Don'ts....

- walk on lawn if it is frosted over. Even though this may not kill the turf, damage to the leaf blades can be a precursor to several diseases.
- ♦ Mow lawn with a dull mower blade. Please sharpen mower blades every six weeks.

Late Winter/Early Spring

Pruning

Improves the health of your ornamental trees and shrubs. Important reasons to prune this time of year:

- 1. Much easier to prune when no leaves on trees
- 2. Less chance of transmitting diseases.
- 3. Remove undesirable branches
- 4. Remove crossing or rubbing branches
- 5. Thin the canopy to improve air circulation
- 6. Remove insect egg masses

Mulching/Pine Needles

Mulching protects the root systems from extreme temperature. Retains moisture levels more evenly throughout the year. Controls weeds and beautifies landscape.

Edging

Combine mechanical edging of landscape beds to give a more professional and finished look.
